# MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD AND THE PRESIDENT & CEO

We are pleased to present Mid-South Food Bank's 2008 Annual Report. We are particularly proud that we ended the year on budget, while one-third of American non-profits showed a deficit. We did, however, see a tremendous increase in the need for food assistance in our service area. Unemployment, housing instabilities and the overall economic downturn took a toll. The trend continues into 2009 with our member emergency food pantries, soup kitchens and shelters all reporting increased numbers of individuals and families seeking food. Our agencies thank us for helping in hard times.

You will read about some of our accomplishments in the Highlights section. A great source of pride is the recognition we received as Non-Profit Organization of the Year from the Community Foundation of Northwest Mississippi. Mid-South Food Bank serves 12 counties in Tennessee, one in Arkansas and 18 in Mississippi. We changed our name to Mid-South Food Bank this year so that our name reflects our commitment to north Mississippi, west Tennessee and east Arkansas.

In 27 years, Mid-South Food Bank has provided more than 213,000 million pounds of food and other grocery items to our network of charitable feeding programs. We face the challenge of having enough nutritious food for our agencies. In spite of this, the amount of food distributed to our agencies increased by four percent in 2008. Mid-South Food Bank has risen to face the challenge, thanks to the generosity of caring supporters enabling us to use our resources efficiently. Our warehouse stays busy and our trucks keep rolling, thanks to the support of this community.

Mid-South Food Bank is uniquely positioned to respond and help, even participation in disaster relief. It is the only Mid-South organization, public or private, to distribute wholesome foods to qualified charities year round. We are the most effective organization to carry out the work of feeding hungry and needy people and, with your help, we will continue to work toward our vision of a hunger-free Mid-South. We are very grateful for your support.

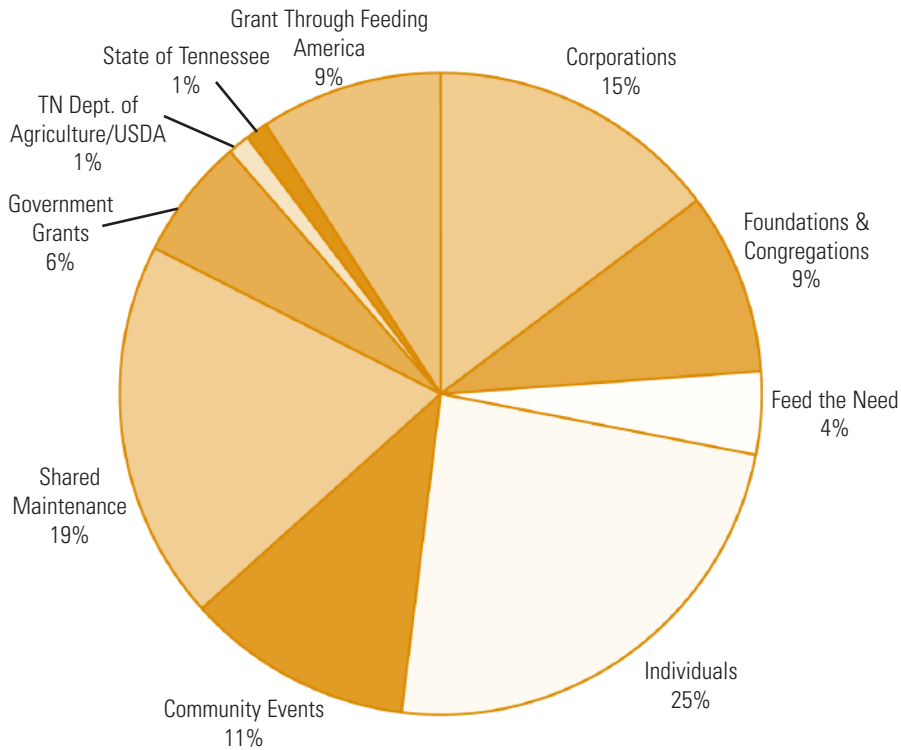

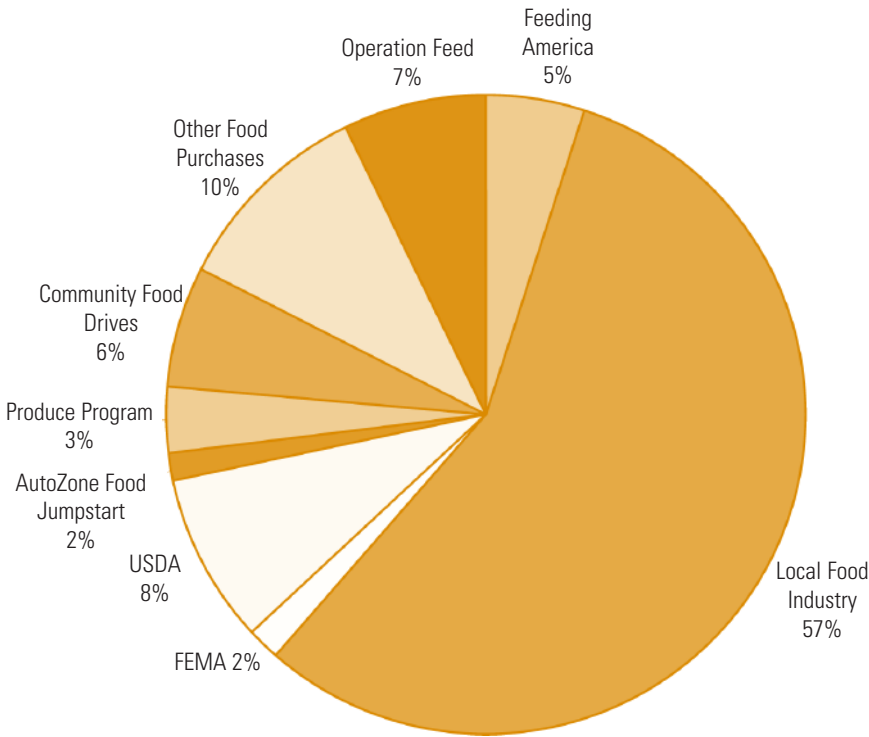

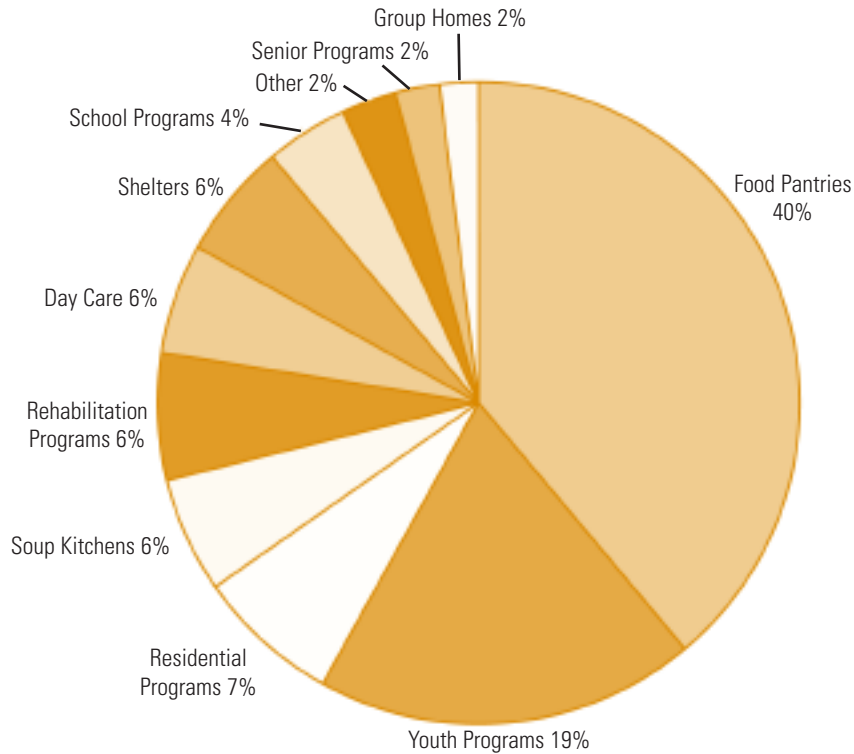

### New Name

In 2008, Mid-South Food Bank became our official, legal name. For years, the slogan "Feeding the Need Throughout the Mid-South" was familiar in our service area, but the new name solidifies our commitment to our communities, the 31 counties in west Tennessee, north Mississippi and east Arkansas that make up our Mid-South service area. Our web site address also changed to [www.midsouthfoodbank.org](http://www.midsouthfoodbank.org).

America's Second Harvest – The Nation's Food Bank Network changed its name to **Feeding America**.

### Distribution

Mid-South Food Bank distributed **8,962,012 pounds** of food and grocery items in 2008, the equivalent of more than 7,170,000 meals. In its 27 years, Mid-South Food Bank has distributed more than 213,000,000 pounds of food and other groceries.

With the average wholesale value of \$1.49 per pound, the worth of the food distributed was \$13,353,400. Our member agencies shared maintenance (handling) fees averaged 10 cents per pound for a **yearly savings of \$12,018,000 in food costs** for the agencies by accessing food at Mid-South Food Bank.

Mid-South Food Bank serves a total of **210 agencies with 305 charitable feeding programs**.

To build capacity, Mid-South Food Bank obtained **grants through Feeding America** that enabled us to purchase 18 new refrigerators and freezers and 15 new computers for selected agencies through a competitive application process. The grant also allowed Mid-South Food Bank to replace outdated refrigerator and freezer units at its Dudley warehouse so that we can safely store more frozen and perishable items for the agencies with much more efficient access to those items.

### Special Recognition

The Community Foundation of Northwest Mississippi recognized Mid-South Food Bank as the **Outstanding Non-Profit of the Year**. The Award was presented at their annual Crystal Ball.

The first annual Mid-South Food Bank **Volunteer Recognition** event was held in 2008. Awards were given to Mimi Hall Uhlmann as Board Member Volunteer of the Year; Vincent Dailey as Volunteer of the Year; the Junior League of Memphis for Childhood Hunger Program Volunteer of the Year; Yvonne Tate of Shelby County Government for Operation Feed Steering Committee Volunteer of the Year; Temple Israel for Faith Based Volunteer Organization of the Year; Hollywood Success Academy for Volunteer School of the Year; International Paper for Volunteer Company of the Year; WMC-TV 5 for Media Volunteer of the Year; and Associated Wholesale Grocers for Food Donor of the Year. Richard L. Tillman, retired president of Kroger Delta Marketing Area received the first James H. Prentiss Lifetime Achievement Award.

### Childhood Hunger

A new **Kids Cafe**, sponsored by CN Railroad, began at the Boys & Girls Club of Northwest Mississippi, Sardis Unit, serving a hot meal to more than 85 children twice a week. Mid-South Food Bank's four Kids Cafes served nutritious meals to more than 500 children a month.

The **Food for Kids Backpack Program** expanded in Mississippi with additional funding from MGM Mirage/Gold Strike Casino to include the two satellite locations of the Boys & Girls Club of the Mississippi Delta in White Oak and Dundee, Mississippi. MGM Mirage/Gold Strike already sponsored the program in Tunica. The 11 Backpack Programs in Memphis and North Mississippi served more than 1,200 children with backpacks full of wholesome food to take home every weekend during the school year.

### Special Events

Mid-South Food Bank purchases a significant amount of food, due to the decrease in donated food, so **Operation Feed**, the workplace food drive, emphasizes monetary donations by awarding the most points for each dollar. Seventy-one companies raised \$424,000 for the Food Bank to use for food purchases and collected more than 73,000 pounds of food.

The **Feed the Need** scan card program in area Kroger, Schnucks, Piggly Wiggly, Cooper's Neighborhood Markets, Parkway Village Super Markets, Stepherson's Food Stores and Miss Cordelia's Market raised \$179,931. Pepsi once again sponsored the program.

The Memphis Restaurant Association's **Feed the Need Week** raised \$18,000 through donations from member restaurants who also collected donations from customers. In addition to the participating restaurants, MRA Feed the Need Week is sponsored by Allied Waste, AmeriPride Linen, AutoChlor, Anheuser Busch and other Memphis Restaurant Association member companies.

Mid-South elementary and middle schools raised more than 380,000 pounds of food in the 22<sup>nd</sup> annual **Kids Kan** school food drive. Kroger again served as the lead sponsor, as they have since Kids Kan began. Other sponsors were FOX13, FM100, Comtrak Logistics, FedEx, Wendy's, General Truck Sales and Two Men and a Truck.

Local members of the National Association of Letter Carriers helped **"Stamp out Hunger"** by collecting donated food as they delivered the mail. The event raised 106,000 pounds of food.

The Boy Scouts of America, Chickasaw Council held its annual **Scouting for Food** drive, with collection help from Two Men and a Truck. Shelby County Mayor A C Wharton served as the honorary chairman. The event raised more than 60,000 pounds of food, more than double the previous year.

Feeding America announced that September is now Hunger Action Month. Mid-South Food Bank participated with a day-long food drive to fill an 18-wheeler in the parking lot at Poplar Plaza Shopping Center. With sponsorship from Fox 13, Finard Properties and Kroger, 10,686 pounds of food and \$3,224 were collected.

Ridgeway Country Club was the course and the food was by Corky's Barbecue for the **AutoZone Food Bank Golf Classic**. A total of 34 teams helped to raise more than \$25,000 for Mid-South Food Bank. Additional sponsors included Cummins Mid-South, Allied Waste, Kroger, Pepsi, Unilever, AmeriPride, FedEx Express, The Peabody Hotel and Cargill.

The **Student Food Drive** saw students from 20 area high schools raise more than 80,000 pounds of food for Mid-South Food Bank. Tyson Foods and Feeding America sponsored the drive nationally, with local sponsorship from WMC-TV 5, Kroger, Paragon Bank, Roadshow BMW and radio station 93X. Mark Prestidge, president of Kroger Delta Marketing Area, was the chairman.

The second annual **Action News 5 Holiday Food Drive** broadcast live from six Mid-South locations including Mid-South Food Bank, Kroger Stores, Schnucks Stores and Wal-Mart, with additional food drop offs at St. Francis hospitals and Church's Chicken. The event raised 71,000 pounds of food and \$30,000, plus an additional \$25,000 from Kroger.
